

Sunday, November 2 - Kahului, Maui - It's hard to believe that each island is so utterly different, and Maui is no exception. It was voted six years in a row to be the "best island in the world", as well as having some of the world's best beaches, waterfalls and rainforest. Maui also offers world famous lu'aus, including the Pacific Paradise Lu'au. Thanks to our overnight stay, we'll have plenty of time to enjoy this cultural extravaganza. Afterward, we can return to the ship for more fun and relaxation onboard.

Monday, November 3 – Kahului, Maui – (optional tour to Lana'i available)

There's plenty of time today to check out the Maui Ocean Center or the Iao Valley tour. Eco-tourists love the Rainforest Eco-Walk. We sail for Hilo, on the big Island of Hawaii at 6:00 pm. Tonight we can see a fabulous Broadway or Vegas-style show at the Hollywood Theater onboard our ship.

<u>Tuesday, November 4 - Hilo, Hawaii – Evening sail by Mount Kilauea-</u> Thanks to its 128 inches of annual rain, Hilo is a lush, tropical, misty city filled with flowers, trees and Victorian charm. We can't miss the unforgettable Volcanoes National Park and Rainbow Falls tour. There are many optional shore excursions available at each of the ports.
