DAY 1: Join Ionosphere as we board our motorcoach and travel through Georgia and into **Tennessee**, en route to **Nashville**, for our first overnight. We enjoy a fantastic **dinner cruise** tonight onboard the **General Jackson** on the waters of the **Cumberland River**. (D)

DAY 2: Following breakfast this morning, we depart for St. Louis, Missouri. **Lunch will be included** enroute. Day 1: Join Ionosphere Tours as we begin our exciting tour to the **Canadian Rockies and beyond!**. During the next **21 days** we will explore some of North America & Canada's most beautiful scenery. Today we leave the South behind and travel through Georgia, Tennessee and Kentucky enroute to **Illinois** and our overnight accommodations in **Marion**. Lunch will be included today (L)




Day 3: Following breakfast we continue our journey, spending much of the morning in **Iowa**, before turning westward into **South Dakota.** In the late afternoon we take the loop drive through **Badlands National Park**, making a stop at the Visitor's Center. Dinner will be included in Wall, South Dakota, home to the famous Wall Drug Store--a most unusual place. We'll have our included dinner and time for a little shopping before we check into our hotel in Wall. (B,D)

Day 4: We get an early start and continue travel westward into **Wyoming** this morning. We head toward Sheridan in the **Big Horn Mountains**, the scene of many fierce battles between the U.S. Cavalry and the Sioux, Cheyenne and Crowe Indians. Following lunch we will visit Fort Phil Kearny. Fort Phil Kearny was one of three U.S. Army forts established along the Bozeman Trail in 1866. Named after deceased Civil War General Philip Kearny (pronounced car-nee) the fort's mission was to protect travelers along the Bozeman Trail against Indian attack. By mid-afternoon we depart, heading north into Montana and stop overnight in **Billings**, in the heart of Yellowstone Valley. **Dinner will** be included tonight. (B,D)

Day 5: We depart this morning and continue to explore **Montana.** We'll make a stop in **Great Falls**, to visit the **C.M. Russell Museum.** This unique museum displays watercolors, sculptures and oil paintings of the cowboy artist Charles Russell. We will overnight in the **Browning**, Montana area. We'll have an included dinner tonight. (**B**,**D**)

Day 6: Following breakfast we'll take a short drive to Lake Mary Visitor Center in Glacier National Park. We'll step aboard our special touring vehicles for an Eastern Alpine excursion that travels the "Going to The Sun" highway, one of the most outstanding scenic roadways in the world. It's a veritable fairyland of snowfrosted peaks and sparking ice caps. This afternoon we will continue our journey northward traveling into **Canada** on our way to Calgary, in the province of Alberta. Calgary is the second largest city in Alberta and home of the world famous "Calgary Stampede". We'll check into our hotel in Calgary before we depart for an included dinner. Following dinner we'll visit Calgary Tower and enjoy a spectacular view of Calgary and the Canadian Rockies. Located 626 feet above the downtown



core, the Calgary Tower offers the best view in the city. From the Observation Deck we'll experience a spectacular 360° view of the bustling city, the majestic Rocky Mountains, the foothills, and the prairies. We can stand on the amazing glass floor for a birds-eye view of the city streets below. (B,D)

Day 7: This morning's journey carries us into the even more spectacular scenery as the highway winds and climbs toward **Banff.** We'll be in **Banff National Park**, which surrounds the year round resort of Banff. We will visit the magnificent **Banff Springs Hotel**. We'll also take the 8-minute ride on the **Sulphur Mountain Gondola** for a spectacular view of the surrounding mountains. We'll have free time later today to do some shopping and browsing in the quaint and scenic downtown area, where we just might see an elk grazing in a front yard! We will spend the next two nights in the Banff area. (B)



Day 8: Our journey continues this morning through Magnificent Banff National Park to beautiful **Lake Louise**. This is one of the most photographed spots in Canada, with majestic Victoria Glacier towering in the background. Continuing north, great mountain ranges are on both sides of the road as we climb to elevations above 7,000 feet. Snow-capped peaks rise to more than 11,000 feet above us. Our highlight of the day is sure to be our **snowcoach ride** onto the **Athabasca Glacier**, 2,000-foot thick extensions of the **Columbia Icefield**. We will return to Banff for our overnight accommodations again tonight, where we will enjoy an **included dinner** tonight. (**B**,**D**)

Day 9: We depart Banff this morning and head west, crossing into the province of **British Columbia**. Our journey will take us in the heart of British Columbia's interior. We'll see a spectacular range of scenery as we travel between the high peaks of the **Canadian Rockies** and across the ranchlands of the interior. Today's highlights include the Continental Divide, a view of the Spiral Tunnels, a remarkable feat of railroad engineering, the Kicking Horse Canyon, Rogers Pass and of course the glaciers and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies. Our overnight is in **Kamloops**, **BC** and **dinner will be included**. (**B**,**D**)

Day 10: Following breakfast our journey continues west towards the Pacific Ocean and the city of **Seattle, Wash-ington.** On today's journey we will again see dramatic changes in scenery, from the desert-like environment of the interior, through the winding river canyons and pristine forests, to the Coast and Cascade Mountains and the lush green fields of the Fraser River Valley. Highlights include the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River and the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon. On arrival in Seattle we'll include admission to the **Space Nee-dle**, which is 650 feet high and has been Seattle's signature structure since it was built as the centerpiece for the 1962 World's Fair. We will overnight in the **Seattle** area, and **Lunch will be included** today.

Day 11: Following breakfast we board our motorcoach and head south into **Oregon.** We'll make a stop for an **included lunch** at **Multnomah Falls Lodge**, which is a wonder in itself. Built in 1925 and named the nation's first National Historic Landmark, the lodge structure includes every type of rock found in the Columbia River Gorge. We'll have an amazing view of Multnomah Falls, dropping 620 spectacular feet, and the tallest of the Columbia River Gorge's many waterfalls. On the lower level, you'll find the Multnomah Falls Visitor Center and Gift Shop. Following lunch, we continue south along the scenic, rugged **Oregon coast**, making our way to tiny **Bandon**, **Oregon** for our overnight. (B,L)



Day 12: After breakfast we are on our way, continuing along the coast of Oregon to **Gold Beach**. Here, where the **Rogue River** empties into the Pacific Ocean, we enjoy an unforgettable **Jet Boat excursion** up the river. In this modern world, this Mail Boat is still the only way folks here have of getting their mail! Back onboard our motor-coach, we cross the state line into northern **California**, destined for majestic **Redwood National Park**. Our route carries us deep into the heart of America's greatest **Redwood Forest**, where the tall trees block the sunlight from the sky above. Dinner and overnight are in the lumber town of **Eureka, California**. (**B**,**D**)



Day 13: Following breakfast this morning we leave Fortuna behind, traveling through another magnificent Redwood Preserve, **Humboldt Redwood State Park**, and through the **Avenue of the Giants Lunch will be included** in the Garberville area. The **San Francisco** skyline is a sight that is sure to take your breath away as we dip toward San Francisco Bay, and enter the incredible span of the **Golden Gate Bridge**. We spend the night in the area of, **San Francisco, California. (B,L)**

Day 14: We'll head to the **Fisherman's Wharf** area following breakfast this morning. We'll love San Francisco's breathtaking waterfront, as we cruise under the majestic Golden Gate Bridge and around notorious Alcatraz Island, on a **Golden Gate Bay Cruise**. We'll discover San Francisco's history via an award-winning audio commentary, learning of her history, marveling at her architecture, and hearing tales of the fascinating glory days of this marvelous West Coast city. Following our cruise we'll have some free time for browsing and lunch on our own in the Fisherman's Wharf area. Some may want to ride on the world famous "Cable cars". By early afternoon we depart for **Yosemite National Park area**. We'll have accommodations in this area tonight and we'll **include dinner**. (B,D) **Day 15:** A region of unusual beauty, **Yosemite National Park** lies on the western slope of the Sierra Nevada. The park is much greater both in area and beauty than most people realize. After breakfast this morning we will have a **narrated tram tour** of this awesome park that Abraham Lincoln set aside as the nation's first state park in 1864. Twenty-six years later Yosemite became a National Park. Later today we depart for the **Reno/Lake Tahoe** area, where we will spend the night. The evening will be free to enjoy on our own, following an **included Dinner** at the hotel. **(B,D)**



Day 16: Following breakfast we continue our exciting journey. We depart for **Salt Lake City, Utah**, where we have accommodations tonight. Founded in 1847 by the Mormons under the leadership of Brigham Young, the city first became the capital of the Mormon settlement and then of the state of Utah. This evening we'll have an **included meal** at one of the area's favorite restaurants. **(B,D)**

Day 17: Leaving Salt Lake City this morning, we cross into **Colorado**, headed for **Colorado Springs**, where we have accommodations for the next two nights. Colorado Springs is 6,000 feet above sea level, which may explain why it was chosen as home of the high-flying U.S. Air Force Academy. West of the city, 14,110-foot Pike Peak stands tall, providing a lovely alpine backdrop. **Dinner will be included** at one of Denver's local restaurants, enroute to Colorado Springs. (**B**,**D**)



Day 18: Following breakfast this morning we will make our way to the base of Pike's Peak at the foot of the Rockies. We'll take the **Pikes Peak Cog Railway** to the top for an unbeatable view. Following our Cog Railway adventure, we will visit the **U.S. Air Force Academy**. Grounds include a B-52 bomber display, scenic overlooks, a chapel, planetarium and Falcon Stadium. We will also be awed as we a drive through the **Garden of the Gods**, a 1300-acre park with massive red sandstone formations. Among them are the Kissing Camel and Balanced Rock. The sun accentuates the color of the stone. Overnight will again be in Colorado Springs, and **lunch will be included** today. **(B,L)**

Day 19: It's time to bid farewell to Colorado as we head east this morning. We'll be on I-70 all day today as we travel into **Kansas**. We'll drive by **the Eisenhower Presidential Library and Museum in Abilene**, **KS.** We'll catch a glimpse of the boyhood home of President Dwight David Eisenhower. This is also the final resting place of Dwight D. and Mamie Doud Eisenhower. We'll **include dinner** in the Abilene area before we continue on to **Topeka**, where we will spend the night. **(B,D)**

Day 20: Today, our journey takes us into Missouri. This afternoon we marvel at the Gateway Arch and get our cameras ready for a picture of this amazing structure. **Lunch will be included** today. We cross the Mississippi where it joins the Ohio River, as we make way for **Paducah**, **Kentucky**, where we have accommodations for tonight. (B,L)

Day 21: We'll spend our last day of this tour traveling through the beautiful mountains of Tennessee as we turn our thoughts toward home. It's been an unforgettable tour. We'll never forget our experiences and our fellowship with our friends. **(B)**





In 1899, the world's first Northern Lights observatory was built on Halddetoppen just outside of Alta. But Finnmark's largest city has more to offer than bright dancing lights. Alta's the gateway to unspoiled beauties such as the Finnmarksvidda plateau and the Sautso, often called Northern Europe's Grand Canyon. From the UNESCO-protected rock carvings at the Alta Museum to the fascinating Sami culture, Alta is a tantalizing treasure just waiting to be discovered. Our ship will dock at 11:00 am Friday, and depart at 1100 pm Saturday.

Day 10 - Sunday, October 5 - At Sea- You'll have a full day to take advantage of all the shipboard activities!

Day 11 - Monday, October 6 - Lofoten Islands (Gravdal), Norway- Gravdal is one of the largest villages in Vestvågøy and part of the Lofoten Archipelago in northern Norway. Drivers will not be responsible for bringing these items to the rooms or for providing access to these bags until the end of the day.

Gratuities:

All necessary tips to bellmen, doormen, and dining room tips on meals in the itinerary are included.

Meals:

Meals are covered if so stated in the itinerary. The following codes describe what meals can be expected: B – Breakfast (Breakfast may be a full or a continental breakfast), L - Lunch, D - Dinner

What's Not Included:

Meals: Other than meals stated on the itinerary.

Personal expenses: Room Service, telephone calls and all other items of a personal nature.

Gratuities to Tour Director and Driver: Gratuities are appreciated, and the amount is always at your discretion.

Suggestions - \$3.00-\$5.00 per person per day for your Tour Director and \$3.00-\$5.00 per person per day for your Driver.

Gratuities on Cruises: You will be given guidelines from the Cruise Company for expected tipping.

DEPARTURE and RETURN POINTS:

We will depart and return to the same locations on each of our tours. The following is a list of those places. In some cases if you are the only passenger at a location, we may ask you to join us at a nearby location. Anderson, SC – Walmart on Liberty Hwy.; Lavonia, GA– Silo Center- exit 173 off I-85; Grovetown, GA– Walmart exit 190 off I-20; N. Augusta, SC – Walmart Hwy 25 (Edgefield Rd.) near I-20; Aiken, SC – Walmart Hwy 1.

OTHER DEPARTURE and RETURN POINTS:

We will also pick up along most major routes, such as I-20, I-85, I-95, and I-75 when the tour travels through a city on both its departure and return. Ask for details when you call to make your reservation!

A **special** pick-up for a group depends upon the number of passengers, distance involved, and length of the tour. All special pickups *must* be approved.

Our departure locations are doing you and Ionosphere Tours a service by allowing us to use their establishments for arrivals and departures. Not all of these locations allow parking. If you must leave a vehicle parked while on tour, kindly check with someone at that pick-up point. Neither these locations nor Ionosphere Tours are responsible should damage occur to your vehicle. Please be at your departure point and *visible* at least ten (10) minutes prior to your scheduled departure time.

THE STAY IS ON US:

Ionosphere Tours offers a maximum of \$90.00 towards an overnight stay prior to the tour departure to anyone subject to all of these conditions:

- Takes a tour of 5 days or more in duration.
- Lives more than 70 miles from the *nearest* available pick-up point for that tour.
- *Verifies* pick-up point and *requests* the \$90.00 refund and provides a receipt for the overnight room. (When the tour departure time is late enough to allow you to drive to the departure point that morning, an overnight stay is not warranted.)
