We'll enjoy a relaxing **riverboat cruise** aboard the Mark Twain, an authentic Mississippi River paddlewheeler, following an **included lunch** at the dock. Following the cruise we visit Mark Twain's boyhood home and museum, and see the house of his sweetheart, Becky Thatcher. We will spend the night in downtown Hannibal and dinner will be on our own in the area of our hotel. (B,L)

DAY 4: Our travels continue into Iowa. We'll have lunch on our own in Le Claire with a little time to explore the unique shops along Cody Road. Now it's time to travel to **Davenport**, **IA** for a visit to **Isabel Bloom Studio** for a **guided tour** that will take us behind the scenes for access to every step in the making of each Isabel Bloom sculpture Next, we will travel to Moline, Illinois, for a stop at the John



**Deere Pavilion**, to see an impressive showcase of vintage and modern-day farm equipment. Interactive displays allow us to sit in the cab of a harvester, or take a virtual tour through the Harvester Works, the company's local combine factory.
